You may find: giraffes, bears, a (real!) stuffed bobcat, flocks of flamingoes, monkeys, pigs, turtles, eagles, macaws, narwahls, penguins, trout, and more. They may be stuffed animals, stone, wood, plastic, inflatables or painted on a door or made of lights. They may be hiding in a tree, sitting on a porch, on a second story balcony
